Please read Matthew 13:35-40. The last line reads..... "Amen, I say to you whatever you did for one of these least brothers of mine, you did it for me."


JNS reflects Jesus' teaching of love through kind acts. Once again I remind you to nominate children whenever you see or hear of something extraordinary for others.
