Powhiri and New to School Meeting—Save the date: Friday 16 March 9am-11am!

Any student who has started St Anne's this year, term four last year, will do later this term or is due to start in term two will be welcomed to the school this day. Because our students usually start on their 5th birthday, it is hard to do a formal welcome for individuals. Families are invited and encouraged to attend with them. The powhiri (welcome) will be around 30 minutes. Following this, all parents/caregivers attending are asked to stay for the 'new to school' meeting. During this we will go over how the school works and all the ins and outs so you will be 'up with the play.' We welcome all questions during this also. We have representatives from the BOT, the PFA, Kidsbase, staff and the Mission Sisters there as well to help you understand our school. Please try to get one parent there if possible (hence we have given as much warning as possible).



New Classes

Learning Conferences and Meet the Teacher

BOOKING YOUR INTERVIEWS

The booking website will open Friday, 16 February at 7:00pm, and will close Monday, 5 March at 9:00 pm

- 1. Go to parentinterviews.co.nz, enter the event code 9ZXZY6HK and click Go.
- 2. Enter your name, email address and the names of the students you wish to make bookings for.
- 3. Select the teachers you'd like to book by ticking the checkbox beside their name, and then click the Book Interviews button at the bottom of the page.
- 4. Using the timetable, click the Book button beside the time slot you'd like to book for the teacher. You'll be asked to confirm your booking.
- 5. Continue until you've booked all teachers.

Once you're finished, you can view your timetable by clicking My Interviews at the top of the page. You can also print a PDF timetable to take to your interviews.

Before your interviews, you'll receive an email reminder containing your timetable. If you need to cancel any interviews, you can do so by following the link in the email you received when you first signed up.




Uniform
