### What is a Holy Day of Obligation?

These are certain feast days in the liturgical year on which Church law obliges Catholics to *'participate in the Mass and to refrain from work or activities that hinder worship, joyful relation and works of mercy'*. Observation of holy days of obligation varies from country to country. In New Zealand, other than every Sunday, Christmas Day and the Feast of the Assumption (August 15<sup>th</sup>) are the two days observed as holy days of obligation.
