#### Rules

All parents I talk to have said how important it is for their child to learn to be caring and respectful. A part of this is to respect the rules of the environment they are in. As parents we need to role model this or our children will think it is okay to not follow rules if we don't follow or care about rules. They mirror us as adults and those around them.

Therefore, please **do not** send food in disposable wrappers to school! **This is a school rule**, initiated by the students thru the Enviro Team who presented a proposal and had it adopted by the Board of Trustees. It is frus-

trating for us all, including the students, to still see rubbish from lunchboxes. Yesterday a group of junior students helped me do a rubbish run, finding well over 150 pieces of rubbish. It was only last week that we last did this.

You may think this rule is stupid and you are entitled to your opinion, but our student led Enviro Team spent so much time on this. It didn't happen overnight. New World also sponsored 80 free lunchboxes to make it easier for parents to go wastefree and also give every new student a unchbox as well if needed.

Remember the students reasons for implementing this rule:

- 1. Healthier foods are not in individual wrappers and we care about our bodies at St Anne's. We promote healthy food.
  - Kei whawhati noa mai te rau o te rātā (referencing non-processed food)
- 2. Waste Skip collection is costly and money saved can be used on resources for learning
- 3. A Catholic school is a dedication to God. We don't mess up Churches nor do we allow litter to ruin our dedication to God.

I can proudly say, my own children have not had waste in their lunches now for over four years. Yes, we squeeze lemon juice onto their apples, buy big yogurts to put in small screw top containers, often toast sandwiches to help them last, which can be a slight hassle but they haven't died yet from slightly harder bread or whatever.

Thank you in advance for your role modelling. While you're at it, please double check another important rule in that your children are wearing 100% correct school uniform and are arriving at school at the correct time. If you need a reminder of what the uniform is please ask at the office.

We really appreciate your assistance in helping your child to respect our school.
