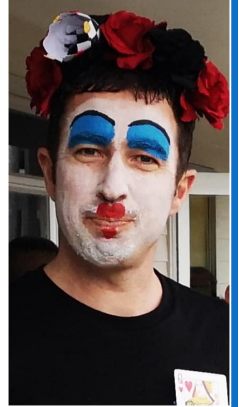

Celebrating Success

Things that give us encouragement:

- We reached another high of 170 students!
- The roll is currently full for 2022, with a waitlist applied! Things can change with people moving with work etc, so ensure you let us know of siblings or friends who want to apply in advance.
- December McVicar completed the Storytelling introduction course.
- Jo Smart, Caitlin Barnes and Amanda Correia completed the Better Start early literacy microcredentials.
- Our Kāhui hub began working together and finished with a Kī o Rahi tournament (St Annes winning the majority of the games).
- Room 5 won the worldwide prize for the most field trips in a year, again.
- Our senior Bball team took out both term competitions.
- Our senior touch team came second overall!
- We held our first Manu Kōrero competition and our speakers were awesome!
- We held our first Filipino Language Week (or half a week, thanks covid).
- We introduced island drumming at school.
- Josh and I, with Janelle Riki-Waaka led a hui for 150 leaders of our Catholic Schools on Māori success. The Ministry has commented on our resources and suggested we apply for the Prime Minister's awards. This was such an affirmation (of course I said that's not how we roll).
- We made the Catholic NZ magazine with our exciting Pentecost celebrations (language booklets, birthday games and 'flame' clothing).
- We farewelled Miss French and Miss Grice (this isn't encouraging, but the point they stayed until retirement says it is not the worst place to be)
- We got our new shade sails up, bought heaps of new sports gear, and are finally getting our super sized chess and draught pieces for behind the hall.
- We helped UC with more videoing and photos for the 2021 intake of Better Start and the majority of our kāhui of 15 schools are in the programme now.
- We survived Mr Halkett, Miss Mapley and Miss Garbes all having a term off with Kāi Tahu in a full immersion environment.
- Five of our staff attended and completed Māori language levels through Te Ahu o Te Māori programme.
- Denise Woods has completed teacher aide professional development at ARA.
- Provided Languagenut for all families including Tagalog, Sāmoan, CI Māori, Māori and all the usual northern hemisphere suspects.
- Ski Trip and Jubilate were awesome experiences.
- The 'Washing Machine' made a return for the GRIT challenge (crazy cross country).
- We 'had a ball' on our Living Springs Camp with amazing students and parent helpers!

Kāhui Achievements:

Miss Clara Mapley has become a contracted artist to the Kāhui Ako (not really but kind of)! Her pictures are simply amazing and give inspiration to her whole class and the Kāhui Ako. The Ipad master!!! Whilst being a big part of the development of these resources, her creativity, amazing classroom programme, and the faithful way she drives our special character, not to mention her leadership as Assistant Principal are also second to none.

Mr Josh Halkett has become famous in the Kāhui Ako for his teaching resources, leadership and knowledge in place based education! He is a role model for the children that learning is fun, interesting and lifelong.

Josh and I constantly share learning together mainly about NZ history, migrational history, Māori language and different dialects as part of our work and resources in the Kāhui. I am so proud of his development as a leader in the Kāhui over the year. He has no 'off button'! I know our Board was proud when we shared our school's journey following the presentation by Janelle Riki-Waaka, about how schools should look, feel and sound.

He was also asked by the University of Canterbury to help develop a teacher training programme for a bilingual pathway for those training to be teachers. In time this will be the norm (you heard it here first), and we will be a school for the trainees to come to on their teaching placements when it begins in 2023.

Me—I'm not going to talk about myself, but to say that I love leading 15 (+5 part timers) Catholic Schools in professional development and I thank our BOT for allowing me to do it. I also thank our staff for this, as it can cause some disruption with one of us darting to a school to run PLD, and not being available for a meeting, or a school ground duty etc. My job is like being a principal of 15 schools, with six DP's and 30 senior leaders to organise. It has a Stewardship Group something like a Board that I report to, a strategic plan, a budget etc. I acknowledge, not all things get done as quickly as they may at school, but I feel our Kāhui team notice the gains outway the negatives.

We also have a bunch of teachers who are stepping up which is fantastic. Mr Isherwood's energy has been great and he likes 'things to happen'. One of my favourite quotes that I like to live by is, "*There are people who make things happen, there are people who watch things happen, and there are people who wonder what happened. To be successful, you need to be a person who makes things happen.*" He and I very much see eye to eye on this!

Congratulations:

December McVicar, who was a fixed term teacher, has secured a permanent full time position at St Anne's. She has done amazing things in Room 3. She was a super coach at McCormick's Bay Touch Rugby and has been involved in Storytelling and Māori language professional development.

Jo Smart has been appointed our Special Educational Needs Coordinator (SENCo) for 2022. She has a lot of knowledge in this area, is extremely organised and will be amazing in this position. We thank Amanda Correia for the work she has done holding the fort since Cathy French finished.

We would like to thank Kyra Robertson for this year. She came this year with an aim to increase the ability of our staff in te reo Māori. She also helped with learning support in classes whilst we were waiting for Denise to move to full time hours. She has been a smiling face in the school and I know many of the children really enjoyed her as part of the team this year and will miss her next year.

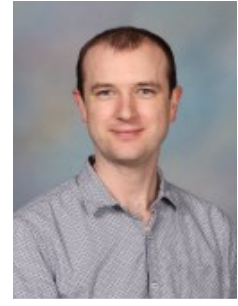

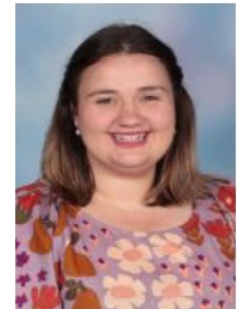

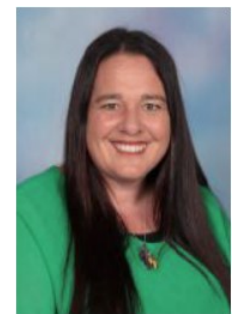
